







These are used to show what is being spoken about.
 When something is NEAR to you, you use one word.
 When something is FAR from you, you use another word.
 If there is more than one item, then there are other words to use.
 This chart shows the words used for each scenario.

NEAR	THIS This is my pencil.  	THESE These are my pencils.  
FAR	THAT That is my pencil.  	THOSE Those are my pencils.
