

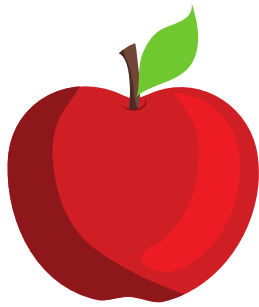
Indefinite Articles

The indefinite articles are A and AN.

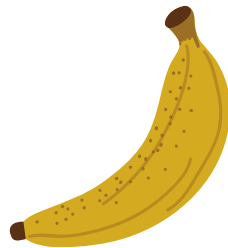
We use AN when the word starts with a vowel (A E I O U)

We use A when the word starts with a consonant.

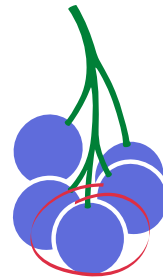
